Subject: International Sanctions Compliance

Dear Sirs,

As a result of the continued conflict in the Ukraine, the EU have implemented a significant change to legislation in relation to products which originate or have been exported from Russia.

The change now prohibits purchase, import and transportation, into or through the EU, of iron and steel products originating in Russia or which have been exported from Russia. This includes components made from materials which originate from Russia e.g. A fabricated item which is made with steel manufactured in Russia such as a valve with a stem which is made from steel manufactured in Russia.

You are therefore required to take immediate action to ensure the compliance with mentioned in the subject matter. By accepting and/or continuing any purchase order from Burckhardt Compression AG or one of its subsidiaries, you are guaranteeing compliance with all applicable international sanctions in relation to such purchase order.
